What is Sexual Harassment?

- Section 2(n), Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (Act of 2013)
- Section 354 A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860

Objective of the Act of 2013

- Provide protection against sexual harassment of women at workplace.
- Prevention and Redressal of complaints of sexual harrassment.

Background

- Constitutional Mandate: Article 14, 15, 19(1)(g),
 21
- Convention on Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW): Article 11 provides State Parties to take all appropriate measures to eliminate discrimination against women in the field of employment.
- Vishaka & Ors v State of Rajasthan & Ors (1997(7) SCC 323)
- Medha Kotwal Lele and Ors. vs. Union of India (AIR 2013 SC 93)

Scope of the Act of 2013

Section 4(o) of the Act of 2013 defines workpace and even includes a dwelling place or a house.

Duties of Employer

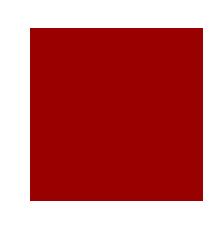
